Indictments of Geno Marconi and Bradley Cook

Concord, NH – Attorney General John M. Formella announces that the Rockingham County Grand Jury has returned indictments against Geno Joseph Marconi of Stratham, New Hampshire, and Bradley Joseph Cook of Hampton, New Hampshire.

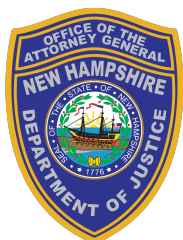
Geno Marconi was indicted for two class B felonies – Tampering with Witnesses and Informants (RSA 641:5, II) and Falsifying Physical Evidence (RSA 641:6, I). Geno Marconi was also indicted for four class A misdemeanors – two counts of Driver Privacy Act Violations (RSA 260:14, IX(a)) and two counts of Obstructing Government Administration (RSA 642:1, I).

Bradley Cook was indicted for the class B felony of Perjury (RSA 641:1, I) and two counts of class A misdemeanor False Swearing (RSA 641:2, I(a)).

Class B felonies are punishable by up to 3.5-7 years in state prison and a fine of up to \$4,000.00. Class A misdemeanors are punishable by up to 12 months in a house of corrections and a fine of up to \$2,000.00.

Geno Marconi is the Director of the Division of Ports and Harbors of the Pease Development Authority, a state agency, and has been on administrative leave since April of 2024. Bradley Cook is the chairman of the Division of Ports and Harbors Advisory Council.

These cases were investigated by the New Hampshire Department of Justice and the Rockingham County Grand Jury and are being prosecuted by Senior Assistant Attorney General Dan A. Jiménez and Assistant Attorney General Joe M. Fincham II of the Public Integrity Unit.
