The Pease Development Authority ("PDA") Board of Directors authorizes the Executive Director to accept and bind insurance coverages for the PDA through Fred C. Church Insurance as outlined in the attached Commercial Insurance Proposal, and to pay the projected total premium amount of \$456,136.28, for the stated policy periods; all in accordance with the memorandum of Anthony I. Blenkinsop, Deputy Director/General Counsel, dated December 13, 2022, also attached hereto.

At the September 15, 2022, meeting of the PDA Board of Directors, the Board authorized the Executive Director to enter into an agreement with Fred C. Church Insurance, Inc. to provide insurance brokerage services to the PDA for a period of up to five (5) years. The brokerage services cover all lines of insurance – workers' compensation, property, and liability. With the PDA's current coverages set to expire on December 31, 2022, Fred C. Church has provided renewal proposals for applicable lines of coverage as set forth below.

#### **Workers Compensation:**

Attached you will find a renewal proposal in the amount of \$89,705.00 for the upcoming renewal period of December 31, 2022, through December 31, 2023. Also please find loss history charts which reflect the fact that PDA's experience modification factor increased from 0.81 to 1.02 for the upcoming renewal period. The projected premium is an increase over last year's premium of \$82,929.00. This year's increase is largely due to a continued hardening of workers compensation insurance markets overall, as well as PDA claims history in 2021. Please see the Workers Compensation Premium Comparison toward the end of the Proposal for a comparison of the premium breakdown from last year and for this upcoming year. As a reminder, such coverage does not extend to employees of the Division of Ports and Harbors who have been historically covered, and continued to be covered, by the State of New Hampshire's self-insured Workers Compensation program.

Overall this is an acceptable renewal proposal with a solid insurance carrier (MEMIC/AM Best Rating A IX). Finally, please note that as the policy is subject to audit the premium may adjust up or down slightly from the projected amount.

#### Property:

Attached please find a proposed premium proposal summary for the upcoming year. Fred C. Church negotiated a renewal in the projected amount of \$208,619.00. This coverage is applicable to PDA facilities which are owned, occupied or controlled by PDA (e.g., the Airport Passenger Terminal Building, the Air Traffic Control Tower, 55 International Drive). As to PDA owned buildings leased to third parties, tenants are responsible for securing property and other applicable coverages in accordance with the lease terms.

The renewal premium represents a 36% increase over last year's premium rate, which is a function of the continuing hardening of the insurance market nationally due to issues such as wildfires, flooding, and more severe/frequent storms. Most impactful however is the fact that PDA property values have increased, most notably with the airport terminal expansion, which is now fully included for the renewal period. In addition, business income and computer equipment values have increased as well. PDA's individual claims history continues to be minimal.

#### Liability:

Fred C. Church has obtained quotes for the following insurance coverages for the PDA:

- 1. Commercial General Liability (\$40,724.00):
- 2. Commercial Auto (\$25,505.00);
- 3. Excess Liability (\$42,178.50);
- 4. Crime/Employee Dishonesty (\$5,232.00);
- 5. Employment Practices (\$8,152.00);
- 6. Aviation Liability (\$23,634.00);
- 7. Pollution Liability (Skyhaven Airport Av Gas tank only) (\$7,297.55); and
- 8. Cyber Liability (\$5,089.23).

Attached please find a proposed premium summary for these lines for the upcoming year at pages 23-24 of the Proposal. As you will note, there have been some increases and some decreases across the different lines. For example, the Aviation Liability premium is down 37%. Cyber Liability, which has seen dramatic increases across the national market, was held to a minimal 8% increase, largely due to PDA's diligence in implementing multi-factor authentication.

At the December 15, 2022, meeting of the Board representatives of Fred C. Church will be in attendance to walk the Board through this Proposal. At that time, please seek authority to bind the above-referenced insurance coverages through Fred C. Church Insurance, Inc. and to pay the projected premiums in the total amount of \$456,136.28<sup>2</sup> for the forthcoming policy period of December 31, 2022, through December 31, 2023<sup>3</sup>.


